21ST WSGA WOMEN IN GOLF SHOOT OUT NORTH WINS

Congratulations to WSGA northern Women In Golf (WIG) ladies for winning the WIG North South Shootout held, September 24 - 25, 2011 at Starfire and Stone Creek Golf Courses in Phoenix, AZ. Since the early 1990's, WSGA Aid to Women Golfers started the Shoot Out as a one day event to encourage more women play. The Shootout has been held at Blacklake, Avila Beach, Redhawk, Solvang, Ridge-mark, Woodcreek, and Shadow Ridge Golf Courses. This was the first year for a two day tournament, raising the ante for increase competitive between north and south WSGA ladies. Way to go Northern Ladies! You've got "bragging rights" for a couple of years!

Sacramento Area Black Golf Club Juniors dominate Western States Golf Association Jr. Championships. Hit Jackpot in Las Vegas

Six Sacramento area SABGC Junior golfers and chaperones Harry Block, President SABGC and Dr. James W. Reede, Jr., traveled to the Western States Golf Association Jr. Championship held in Las Vegas, August 2-5.

James W. Reede, III of Monterey Trail HS took 1st Place and his victory made him the first of the automatic qualifiers for the 2012 - 37th Annual Junior PGA Championship. However, James was not alone in his victory in the field of sixty 15-17 year-old golfers. Julian A. Woodfork of McClatchy HS placed 3rd and Will H. Smartt II of Kennedy HS placed 10th. In the 18-College Division, Cody Moore of Franklin HS Elk Grove placed 2nd for the Men's Flight with Alexis Carrington of Granite Bay finishing 2nd in the Women's Flight. Azra Carrington finished 6th Place in the 13-14 Girls Division.

The three 17 year-olds, James, Julian, and Will, members of both SABGC and First Tee of Greater Sacramento, had befriended Champions Tour and Charles Schwab Cup winner Loren Roberts in 2009 that resulted in his donation of \$70,000 to the Elk Grove Unified School District that preserved the golf programs at the nine Elk Grove high schools. His investment has paid off.

Most of the winning participants received their initial training in the Northern California Minority Junior Golf Scholarship Association's "Youth Golf Training Program," founded by Willie L Simmons, Jr. in 1990, based here in Sacramento.

Reede, Smartt, and Woodfork first improved their golf swings as six, eight & twelve year-olds in the program. Alexis Carrington entered the program as a 4 year old with her sister Azra starting at the same age.
